AUTHORIZATION TO RELEASE CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

- The Wood County CSEA <u>cannot</u> release Federal Tax Information (FTI) to a third party.
- ❖ If the requested information has been filed with the Court, it is a public record and may be obtained from the appropriate Clerk of Court without a release form.
